Once again there were three eight-week sessions of the Open University held at three locations during the year:

- North Side: Ginter Park Presbyterian Church
- South Side: St. Luke Lutheran Church
- West End: First Presbyterian Church

We arc grateful that these congregations have continued to allow The Shepherd’s Center of Richmond to utilize their facilities 24 weeks each year.

People 50 years of age or older attend the Open University. There is a \$25 tuition fee for each eight-week session for members of the Center, \$45 for non-members. One payment allows an individual to attend classes at all three locations. Scholarships are available. There were 1,085 registrations for the fall, winter, and spring sessions of 2004/2005.
